"In 1501 Portuguese explorer Gaspar Corte-Real sailed off, found nothing, and disappeared." This is a part of a story that Hans Shank from Rosedale Bible College told this morning to our high school students as a part of a chapel talk. He used this story to illustrate that we need a map in our lives so that we don't sail off, find nothing, and disappear as well.

I share this as an example of the types of experiences our students at GMS are privileged to have on a regular basis. Whether it is a guest speaker at chapel or a teacher in a regular class, our students are being taught the Word of God and are being challenged to live it daily.

Scripture calls us to, "Fix these words of mine in your hearts and minds; ...teach them to your children, talking about them when you sit at home and when you walk along the road, when you lie down and when you get up."
